The Great May Day - 2026

May 1st is the 137th International Workers' Day— May Day. Red Salute to the struggle that emerged in 1886 at Haymarket, America, demanding an eight-hour workday, fair wages, and dignity, and to the martyrs of that time. The significance of the Great May Day has become even more radiant today. May Day presents us today with the duty of upholding the red flag of the revolutionary struggle to establish a state and social system of the oppressed nations and peoples, including landless peasants, students, women, and the middle class, under the leadership of the working class.

Today, it has become clear across the world that the capitalist-imperialist system is the enemy of the working class, peasantry, and ordinary people. The chieftain of imperialism, the United States, is imposing unjust wars upon the people, including the working class, through aggression, massacres, and market captures worldwide. The European Union, Britain, and Zionist Israel stand as accomplices to the United States. On the other hand, imperialist countries like Russia and China are attempting to expand their own empires under the guise of so-called “anti-US” or “anti-Western” stances, giving rise to newly developing inter-imperialist contradictions.

By putting forward the reactionary ideologies of religious communalism and nationalism, imperialism is destroying the internationalist unity of the working people across various countries. Concurrently, it has escalated massacres and oppression worldwide to destroy the protracted people's war and class struggle guided by the light of Marxism-Leninism-Maoism— the ideology for the liberation of the people, including workers and peasants. Despite facing fierce attacks in countries like Peru, India, the Philippines, and Turkey, Maoist parties continue to wage people's war aimed at liberating the oppressed nations and peoples, including the working class. It is through the rises and falls of this Maoist-Communist movement of the vanguard section of the working class that the protracted people's war will inevitably achieve victory. Furthermore, the struggle of the working class within imperialist countries has also emerged in a more combative and courageous role. Following the path shown by the Paris Commune, the Russian Socialist Revolution, the Chinese Revolution, and the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution, the working class of our country and the entire world will write the epic of its liberation.

In East Bengal, as well as in this country, every other imperialism including the US, Indian expansionism, and their boot-

licking bureaucratic-comprador lackey capitalists and the upholders of semi-feudalism have made the lives of the working class, peasantry, and ordinary people miserable. The wage-slavery of the workers, the landlessness and lack of crop rights for the peasants, and the uncertainty of people's lives have transformed the state and social system into a prison. Migrant, informal, women, and child laborers are subjected to even greater exploitation. Under all regimes, the state forces have been utilized to carry out killings, suppression, and oppression against even the minimal democratic movements of workers and peasants. The new and old parties— including the BNP-Jamaat, Awami League-Jatiya Party, or NCP— all represent the class enemies. Moreover, individuals and organizations bearing the name of NGOs and civil society are also integrated into this exploitative state and social system. Usurping the anti-autocracy and anti-fascism struggles of the workers and the masses, they form governments in various ways courtesy of their imperialist masters. On the other hand, revisionist-reformist parties and organizations bearing the name of 'Left' mislead the political-economic struggle of the workers, leading it into the blind alleys of elections or urban uprisings.

In a country like ours, the only path to developing the revolutionary struggle of the landless-poor peasants and the working-middle class people under the leadership of the working class is Protracted People's War. The working class can advance the revolutionary direction of May Day only by organizing forces of landless-poor peasants under its leadership to prepare bases in rural areas, keeping the agrarian revolution in the center, and by expanding the class struggle through the elimination of the people's class enemies. Armed with Marxism-Leninism-Maoism against the exploitative state system and the ruling class, the working class, as the leader of the revolution, will establish the firm unity of the oppressed people by applying the revolutionary mass line and various methods of armed struggle. The working class will not tolerate any injustice, oppression, or assault in silence; it will inevitably avenge every attack. Come, let us establish a People's Democratic East Bengal of workers, peasants, and the middle class, oriented toward Communism and Socialism!
